


### On-Campus Recycling Guide



## **Recyclable Items**

One bin takes all types of recyclables (Single-Stream Recycling)





- Please make sure recycling is:
  - clean and empty
  - free of food scraps
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Do not place recyclables in a plastic bag
- If in doubt, throw it out



## **Plastics**



#### Acceptable

- Food and beverage containers
  - Plastics #1,2,4,5,7
- rigid plastic containers (pots, buckets, tubs)

#### Unacceptable

- •Plastic wrappers
- •Plastic bags
- •Solo Cups
- •Straws, utensils, lids



## Metal Cans



#### Acceptable

- Steel and Tin food cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Loose metal lids and tabs

#### Unacceptable

- •Scrap metal
- •Electronic Waste (batteries, phones, computers etc.)

• Foil (clean)



#### Acceptable

• Newspapers, Magazines, Office Paper

#### Unacceptable

- Wax coated paper
- •Frozen food boxes

- Books
- Cardboard & Paperboard
- Cartons (clean)



# Glass Containers

#### Acceptable

- Bottles and jars
- Beverage containers
- Food Containers

#### Unacceptable

- •Window glass
- •Mirrors
- •Light bulbs
- •Ceramic and Pyrex
